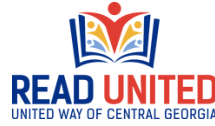

Bridging Healthcare for ALICE with \$470,166: In Houston County, we proudly stand alongside ALICE families, extending support through a range of essential health services. This includes mammograms facilitated by Pink Promise United, medical care offered at the Houston County Volunteer Medical Clinic, and valuable prescription savings made possible through Singlecare. Together, we're breaking barriers to healthcare, ensuring ALICE's access to crucial services.

Empowering Education for ALICE: \$257,884 Invested in Houston County: In Houston County, we're amplifying ALICE families' educational journey. Through investments in Read United and more, we're boosting 3rd grade reading, afterschool programs, child advocates, and early education.

Investing in Basic Needs: \$99,388 Strengthening ALICE in Houston County: In Houston County, we're investing in vital housing programs, a safe haven for survivors of domestic violence, casework support, and a wealth of resources and referrals for the community. Together, we're building a foundation of stability and support, ensuring ALICE's well-being and resilience.

Empowering ALICE: Impacting 1,220 Individuals through Mission United & VITA in Houston County: In Houston County, Mission United and VITA stand strong for ALICE families. Mission United ensures food security and reliable transportation, while VITA provides free tax preparation, ensuring financial stability.
